



Exercise 2 - READING

Read the first part of the extract.

A big, sleepy brown bear appears in front of Akela.

'Baloo!' says Akela, surprised. Baloo teaches the Law of the Jungle to the wolf cubs and he speaks at the meetings of the Council. Everyone likes him because he eats only nuts and honey—he doesn't hunt.

'I can speak for the man cub,' says Baloo with his low voice. 'I can teach him to run with the Pack.' 'Very well,' says Akela.

Another animal silently jumps down into the circle of wolves. It is Bagheera the panther. He is black, brave and strong. He is also very clever.

'Akela, can I speak?' asks Bagheera softly.

'Yes, you can,' says Akela.

'The Law of the Jungle says it's possible to buy the life of a cub,' says Bagheera. 'It's bad to kill a man cub because he can't hurt you. Let him live and I can give you a fat bull to eat.'
