

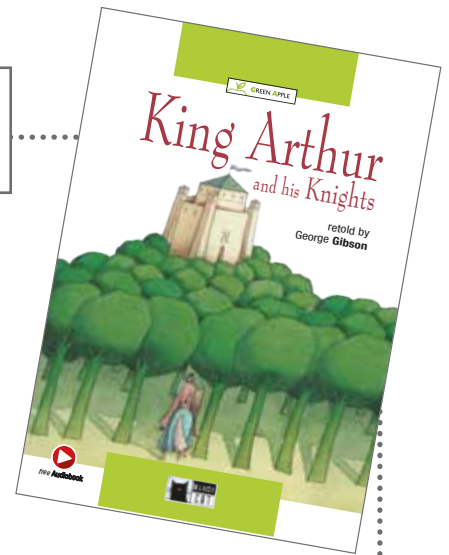

King Arthur and his knights killed the five kings.

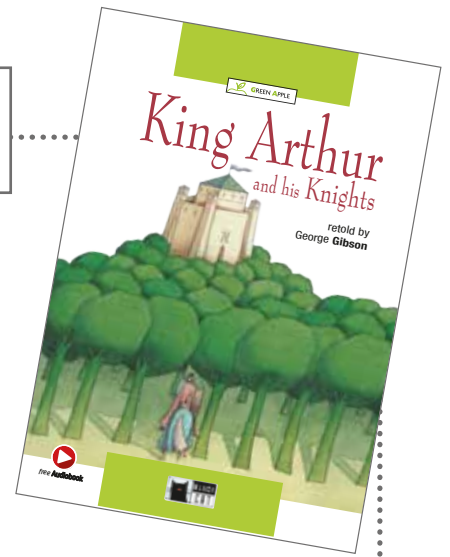
The enemy armies were **10** without their leaders. They all left Britain. King Arthur and his knights were again victorious. They saved Britain from a dangerous invasion.
